INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

Count 1

On or about February 27, 2009, in Luna County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **SALVADOR BAQUERA**, did corruptly and by threat or force influence, obstruct, impede and endeavor to influence, obstruct and impede the due and proper administration of the law under which a pending proceeding was being had before a department or agency of the United States.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1505.

Count 2

On or about February 27, 2009, in Luna County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **SALVADOR BAQUERA**, did use physical force or the threat of physical force against any person with the intent to hinder, delay, and prevent the communication by Rosa Elena Rodriguez-DeMuñoz to a law enforcement officer of the United States of information relating to the commission or possible commission of a Federal offense.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1512(a)(2)(C).

Count 3

On or about April 7, 2009, in Luna County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **SALVADOR BAQUERA**, did unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally possess marijuana.

In violation of 21 U.S.C. § 844.
