Man Sentenced to 108 Months for Burglaries

On March 17, 2010, Leyandrew Joe, 35, an enrolled member of the Navajo Nation, was sentenced by U.S. District Judge William P. Johnson to 108 months in federal prison, to be followed by three years of supervised release. Joe pleaded guilty on November 17, 2009, to two counts of aggravated burglary and one count of burglary. The offenses occurred near Shiprock, New Mexico, within the boundaries of the Navajo Nation Indian Reservation.
