Man Sentenced to 3 Years for Assault Resulting in Serious Bodily Injury

On March 19, 2010, Montoya Johnson, Jr., 34, an enrolled member of the Navajo Nation, was sentenced by U.S. District Judge James O. Browning to 36 months in federal prison, to be followed by three years of supervised release. Johnson pleaded guilty to assault resulting in serious bodily injury. The offense occurred within the boundaries of the Navajo Nation Indian Reservation.
