Man Sentenced to 56 Months for Assault Resulting in Serious Bodily Injury

On May 4, 2010, Jeremiah Belone, 28, an enrolled member of the Navajo Nation, was sentenced by Chief U.S. District Judge Martha Vazquez to 56 months in federal prison, to be followed by three years of supervised release. Belone pleaded guilty on March 4, 2009, to Assault Resulting in Serious Bodily Injury. The offense occurred in Toadlena, New Mexico, within the boundaries of the Navajo Nation Indian Reservation.
