

Count 2

On or about September 23, 2010, in Indian Country, in San Juan County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **MICHAEL LYLE HARRISON**, an Indian, did assault Cherlyncia Yazzie with a dangerous weapon, that is, a knife, with intent to do bodily injury, and without just cause or excuse.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1153 and 113(a)(3).

Count 3

On or about September 23, 2010, in Indian Country, in San Juan County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **MICHAEL LYLE HARRISON**, an Indian, did assault Cherlyncia Yazzie, such assault resulting in serious bodily injury.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1153 and 113(a)(6).

Count 4

On or about September 23, 2010, in Indian Country, in San Juan County in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **MICHAEL LYLE HARRISON**, an Indian, did knowingly, intentionally, and negligently, and without justifiable cause, cause or permit Jane Doe, a child under the age of 18, to be placed in a situation that may have endangered the child's life or health.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1153 and N.M.S.A 1978, § 30-6-1(D).
